This Paper Development Workshop (PDW) sponsored by *EGOS*, in collaboration with the Editors-in-Chief of its two journals – *Organization Studies* and *Organization Theory* – seeks to provide developmental opportunities for advanced PhD students and early career scholars in East Africa who are engaged in research in the field of organization and management studies (from a social science and humanities tradition). The PDW will help participants in enhancing their research and academic writing skills. It also seeks to increase participants' awareness of the requirements, expectations, and procedures involved in the review processes at top peer-reviewed academic journals through presentations and first-hand discussions with established scholars and editors of journals such as *Organization Studies* and *Organization Theory*. The workshop is free of charge and meals are provided. A limited number of stipends will be offered to international participants from the region to cover at least part of the cost for travel and accommodation for participants without institutional funding (up to USD 520.00).

The workshop focuses on improving writing skills and familiarizing participants with the publishing process in journals.

To apply for this PDW

- Submit a brief motivation letter explaining your current career stage, why you think you are a good candidate for this workshop, how the workshop fits your research interests, and how you expect to benefit from the workshop.
- Submit a full paper or an advanced version of an unpublished manuscript in the area of management studies (max 8,000 words) that should include an abstract, introduction, research aim/justification, literature review, empirical design and methods if applicable, findings, discussion, and a conclusion section.
